A free 15 week course for people wanting to meet new people and learn new skills

..... *When?*

Courses run on a Tuesday or a Wednesday from 10am – 2pm






..... *What?*

The free course is Level One Accredited and offers a friendly informal approach learning the process of volunteering in the charity shop. Participants get to meet other volunteers which sets them on a journey of team building, and learning new skills together.

..... *Why?*

Most participants that have completed the course have either continued to volunteer in the shop or have gone on to other jobs or training opportunities. It has also helped them to understand the needs of the customers and the wider community, and as helped to build confidence and self-esteem.
